

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. APPLICATION
1.1 These Conditions shall govern and be incorporated in every contract for the sale of goods made or on behalf of De Novo Interiors Ltd. ("the Seller") with any customer ("the Buyer"). They shall apply in place of and prevail over any terms or conditions, (whether or not in conflict or inconsistent with these Conditions), contained or referred to in any documentation submitted by the Buyer or in correspondence or elsewhere or implied by trade, custom, practice or course of dealing unless specifically excluded or varied in writing by a director or other authorised representative of the Seller and any purported provisions to the contrary are hereby excluded or outweighed.
1.2 Acceptance by the Buyer of delivery of the goods shall without prejudice to Condition 2 or any other manner in which acceptance of these Conditions may be evidenced be deemed to constitute unqualified acceptance of these Conditions.
1.3 It is understood by any contract of sale which is subject to these Conditions, a contract of sale is made with the same Buyer without reference to any conditions of sale or purchase such contract however made shall be deemed to be subject to these Conditions.

2. QUOTATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE
2.1 A quotation by the Seller does not constitute an offer and the Seller reserves the right to withdraw or revise the same at any time prior to the Seller's acceptance of the Buyer's order.
2.2 The Seller's acceptance of the Buyer's order (including telephone orders) shall be effective only when confirmed verbally or in writing by the Seller.
2.3 The Buyer may not cancel any order once accepted by the Seller without the written consent of the Seller and the Buyer will in any event be liable to the Seller for any losses or expenses (including cost of profit) incurred by the Seller in relation to any such cancellation.

3. PRICES
3.1 The prices payable for the goods shall be those set out in the Seller's list of prices current at the time of dispatch or in accordance with any indication given verbally or in writing by the Seller from time to time. The Seller shall have the right at any time to withdraw any discount from its normal prices and/or to revise prices to take account of inflation and/or increases in costs including (without limitation) costs of any goods materials carriage labour or overheads the increase or imposition of any tax duty or other levy and any variation in exchange rates.
3.2 Unless otherwise specified VAT and any other tax or duties payable by the Buyer shall be added to the price.
3.3 Any discount allowed to the Buyer shall be notified to the Buyer from time to time.
3.4 Unless otherwise stated original expenses (including the cost of acquiring or adapting machinery to the Buyer's manufacturing requirements) shall be added to the price and may be charged separately prior to delivery of the goods.
3.5 Installation is not included in prices unless specifically stated.

4. TERMS OF PAYMENT
4.1 Payment of invoices shall unless otherwise agreed in writing be made in full without any deduction or set-off within 30 days of the date of the invoice. Time of payment shall be of the essence of all contracts between the Buyer and the Seller in these Conditions apply. The Seller reserves the right to suspend the provision of goods where any payments are overdue under any contract with the Buyer until all such amounts have been paid.
4.2 Any extension of credit allowed to the Buyer may be changed or withdrawn at any time.
4.3 Interest shall be payable on overdue accounts at the rate of the base National Westminster Bank PLC base rate from time to time to run from the date of payment until paid by the Seller of the full amount whether before or after judgment.
4.4 If at the option of the Seller the creditworthiness of the Buyer shall have deteriorated prior to dispatch of the goods the Seller may require full or partial payment of the price prior to such delivery or the provision of security for payment by the Buyer in a form acceptable to the Seller.
4.5 Notwithstanding any purported contrary appointment by the Buyer all payments made by the Buyer to the Seller shall be accepted first to goods which have been re-sold by the Buyer and then to goods which remain in the possession or order of the Buyer.

5. DELIVERY
5.1 Delivery or dispatch dates mentioned in any quotation, order acceptance form or elsewhere are approximate only and not of contractual effect and the Seller shall not be under any liability to the Buyer in respect of any failure to deliver on any particular date or dates. Time for delivery shall not be of the essence of any contract to which these Conditions apply and shall not be made so by the effect of any notice.
5.2 Delivery shall be at the Buyer's premises unless otherwise stipulated or agreed by the Seller. The cost of delivery shall be included in the price but the Seller shall make an additional charge for delivery in the United Kingdom otherwise than by the normal carrier or for express delivery. Unless agreed in writing the Buyer shall unload and inspect the goods immediately on their arrival at the Buyer's premises. The Buyer shall indemnify the Seller against any and all claims liabilities costs or expenses arising as a result of the Seller or its sub-contractors assisting the Buyer in the unloading, loading or other removal of the goods from the point of delivery.
5.3 If the Buyer refuses or fails to take delivery of the goods tendered in accordance with the contract or fails to take any action necessary on its part for delivery and/or shipment of the goods the Seller shall be entitled to terminate the contract with immediate effect, to dispose of the goods as the Seller may determine, and to recover from the Buyer any fees and additional costs incurred as a result of such refusal or failure (including without limitation storage costs) from the date of delivery.
5.4 Unless otherwise expressly agreed the Seller may effect delivery in one or more instalments. Where delivery is effected by instalments each instalment shall be treated as a separate contract governed by these Conditions.
5.5 Section 32(2) of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 shall not apply. The Seller shall not be required to give the Buyer the notice specified in Section 32(2) of that Act.

6. RISK
6.1 Risk in the goods shall immediately pass to the Buyer upon delivery of the goods into the custody, care or control of the Buyer or its warehouse men, bailee or agents or to the carrier and the Buyer thereafter shall be responsible for all claims, actions and losses arising out of or in any way associated with the goods.
6.2 Any property of the Buyer or in the Seller's possession or control and all property suspected to the Seller on behalf of the Buyer shall be held by the Seller at the Buyer's risk.
6.3 From the time of delivery until property in the goods passes to the Buyer in accordance with Condition 7 the Buyer shall insure the goods for their full value with a reputable insurance company. Upon receipt, the Buyer shall take reasonable endeavours to have the Seller's interest in the goods noted on the insurance policy. Until property in the goods passes to the Buyer the Buyer shall hold the proceeds of any claim on such insurance policy on behalf of the Seller and shall forthwith account to the Seller with such proceeds.

7. TITLE
7.1 Notwithstanding delivery and passing of risk, the goods shall remain the property of the Seller until such time as the Buyer shall have paid to the Seller the agreed price together with any accrued interest and all other amounts owing by the Buyer to the Seller in respect of any other contract for the sale of goods.
7.2 Until property in the goods has passed the Buyer shall be in possession of the goods in a fiduciary capacity and shall: (a) not part with possession of the goods otherwise than in accordance with Condition 7.6; (b) take proper care of the goods and take all reasonable steps to prevent any damage to or deterioration of them; (c) keep the goods free from any charge, lien or other encumbrance and store the goods in such a way to show clearly that they belong to the Seller; (d) notify the Seller forthwith upon the happening of any of the events set out in Condition 17.1 and (e) give the Seller such information relating to the goods as the Seller may from time to time require.
7.3 The Seller reserves the right to repossess and re-sell any goods to which it has retained title and the Seller's consent to the Buyer's possession of the goods and any right to possession of the goods shall not be taken as an agreement to waive any of the above.
7.4 If any sum owed by the Buyer to the Seller (whether in respect of the goods or otherwise) is not paid to the Seller by the date when it is due or (B) upon the happening of any of the events set out in Condition 17.1 or (C) if the Buyer commits a breach of any contract with the Seller.
7.4 The Buyer hereby grants an irrevocable right and licence to the Seller and its servants and agents to enter upon all or any of the Buyer's premises with or without vehicles during normal business hours for the purpose of inspecting and/or re-possessing goods to which it has retained title. This right of licence shall continue to subsist notwithstanding the termination for any reason of any contract which is subject to these Conditions and without prejudice to any accrued rights of the Seller under such contracts or otherwise.
7.5 The Buyer is licensed by the Seller to process goods to which the Seller has retained title in such fashion as it may wish and/or to incorporate them in or with any other products subject to the express condition that the new product or products or any other chattel whatsoever containing any part of the said goods shall become the property of the Seller and shall be separately stored and marked by the Buyer to show clearly that they belong to the Seller. The Seller shall hold the new product or products as trustee for itself and the Buyer and the Seller's interest as a beneficiary of the trust shall be equal to the total of all amounts owing by the Buyer to the Seller under any contract for the sale of goods.

7.6 Where the Buyer is in possession of the goods with the Seller's consent (but not otherwise) the Buyer may in the ordinary course of its business sell or hire the goods or any new product or products produced with the Seller's goods provided that: (a) as between the Buyer and a sub-buyer or customer the Buyer shall sell or hire the goods as principal and the Buyer shall not and shall not be deemed to control the Seller in any contractual relationship with or liability to the sub-buyer or customer or any other person; (b) as between the Seller and the Buyer, the Buyer shall sell or hire the goods in a fiduciary capacity as agent for the Seller; and (C) notwithstanding any agreed order of credit for payment of the price of the goods the Buyer shall pay the proceeds of such sales or hire to the Seller forthwith upon receipt.
The Buyer acknowledges that as a consequence of its fiduciary relationship with the Seller it is under a common law duty to the Seller to hold the proceeds of any such sales or hire in trust for the Seller and to merge such proceeds with any other moneys or pay them into an overdraft bank account, such common law duty being unaffected by and wholly independent of the terms of these Conditions.
7.7 The Buyer agrees immediately upon being requested by the Seller to assign to the Seller all rights and claims which the Buyer may have against its sub-buyers or customers arising from such sales or hire and payment to be made in full as stated above.
7.8 Notwithstanding the provisions of this Condition 7 the Seller shall be entitled to bring an action against the Buyer for the price of the goods in the event of non-payment by the Buyer by the due date even though property in the goods has not passed to the Buyer and/or shall have the right by notice to the Buyer at any time after delivery to pass property in the goods to the Buyer as from the date of such notice.

8. INSTALLATION
8.1 If goods are installed by the Seller the Buyer must allow the Seller reasonable unrestricted access for such installation during normal working hours or as specified in the particular contract.
8.2 The Seller may pass on to the Buyer any reasonable additional expenses or charges incurred through the Buyer's failure to provide unimpeded access or accessible information regarding the premises where goods are to be installed.
9. WARRANTIES IN QUANTITY
The Seller shall be deemed to have fulfilled its contractual obligations in respect of any delivery even though the quantity may be up to 10% more or less than the quantity specified in the contract and in such event the Buyer shall pay for the actual quantity delivered.

10. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS
10.1 The Buyer shall indemnify the Seller against any and all claims liabilities costs and expenses incurred by or made against the Seller as a direct or indirect result of the carrying out of any work required to be done on or to the goods in accordance with the requirements or specifications of the Buyer involving any infringement or alleged infringement of any rights of any third party.
10.2 In respect of all other sales, if at any time any allegation of infringement of patent, copyright or design rights is made in respect of the goods or if in the Seller's reasonable opinion such an allegation is likely to be made, the Seller may at its option and at its own expense modify or replace the goods without detracting from overall performance thereof, so as to avoid the infringement, or (B) procure for the Buyer the right to continue to use the goods or (C) repurchase the goods at the price paid by the Buyer less depreciation at such rate as is applied by the Seller to its own equipment.
10.3 The Buyer shall notify the Seller forthwith of any claim made or action brought or threatened alleging infringement of the rights of any third party. The Seller shall have control over and shall conduct any such proceedings in such manner as it shall determine. The Buyer shall provide all such reasonable assistance as the Seller may require. The cost of any such proceedings shall be borne in such proportions as the parties shall determine.
10.4 Where the Seller or its employees or agents design the goods pursuant to a commission from the Buyer (whether in consideration of an order or otherwise) then any copyright or design rights created in relation to the goods shall vest in the Seller and the Buyer agrees that it shall do any acts and execute any documentation required by the Seller to secure vesting of title to such copyright or design rights to the Seller.

11. LIABILITY
11.1 The Seller shall not be liable to the Buyer: (a) for non-delivery unless a written claim is received by the Seller within 3 days from the date of the Seller's invoice or advice note, whichever is the earlier; (b) for shortages in quantity delivered in excess of those permitted by condition 8 unless the Buyer notifies the Seller of any claim for short delivery within 3 days of receipt of any goods; (c) for damage to or loss of the goods or any part of them in transit where the goods are carried by the Seller's own transport or by a carrier on behalf of the Seller unless the Buyer shall notify the Seller of any such claim within 3 days of receipt of the goods or the scheduled date of delivery whichever shall be the earlier; (d) in respect of the goods caused by fire and sea, abnormal or unsuitable conditions or storage or use or any act, neglect or default of the Buyer or of any third party; (e) for other defects in the goods unless notified to the Seller within 7 days of receipt of the goods by the Buyer or where the defect would not be apparent on reasonable inspection within 3 months of delivery.
11.2 Where liability is accepted by the Seller under Condition 11.1 the Seller's only obligation shall be at its option to make good any shortage or non-delivery and/or as appropriate to replace or repair any goods found to be damaged or defective and/or to refund the cost of such goods to the Buyer.
11.3 The Seller shall not be liable for any loss, damage or liability of any kind suffered by any third party directly or indirectly caused by repairs or remedial work carried out without the Seller's prior written approval and the Buyer shall indemnify the Seller against any and all claims and costs arising out of such claims to the extent that such repairs or remedial work have been performed by the Buyer or its agents.
11.4 The Seller's aggregate liability to the Buyer whether for negligence, breach of contract, misrepresentation or otherwise shall in no circumstances exceed the cost of the defective, damaged or undelivered goods which give rise to such liability (as determined by net price invoiced to the Buyer) in respect of any occurrence or series of occurrences.
11.5 Subject to the condition 11.1:

(a) all conditions warranties and representations expressed or implied by statute common law or otherwise in relation to the goods are hereby excluded;
(b) the Seller shall be under no liability to the Buyer for any loss damage or injury, direct or indirect, resulting from defects in design, materials or workmanship or otherwise howsoever arising and whether or not caused by the negligence of the Seller its employees or agents;
(c) the Seller shall have no liability for any defect or consequential loss or expense suffered by the Buyer, howsoever caused, and including without limitation loss of anticipated profits, goodwill, reputation, business receipts or contracts, or losses or expenses resulting from third party claims.
11.6 The Seller's prices are determined on the basis of the limits of liability set out in this Condition. The Buyer may by written notice to the Seller request the Seller to agree a higher limit of liability provided insurance cover can be obtained for such higher limit. The Seller shall effect insurance up to such limit and the Buyer shall pay upon demand the amount of any and all premiums. The Buyer shall disclose such information as the insurers shall require. In no case shall the Buyer be entitled to recover from the Seller more than the amount received from the insurers.
12. SPECIFICATIONS AND CONFIDENTIALITY
12.1 Unless expressly agreed in writing by the Seller all drawings, designs, specifications and particulars of weights and dimensions submitted by the Seller shall remain the property of the Seller and the Buyer shall have no liability in respect of any deviation from them.
12.2 The Seller accepts no responsibility for any errors omissions or other defects in any drawings, designs, specifications or particulars prepared by the Seller and the Seller shall be indemnified by the Buyer against any and all claims liabilities costs and expenses incurred by the Buyer arising from them.
12.3 Communications to goods required by the Buyer following inspection and approval of goods by the Buyer shall be at the Buyer's expense and will be charged for separately.
12.4 All drawings, designs, specifications and information submitted by the Seller shall be treated as confidential and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the Seller's written consent or used by the Buyer other than for purposes authorised by the Seller.
12.5 The Seller reserves the right to make without notice any changes in materials specifications or design of the goods which having regard to all circumstances it considers to be reasonable or desirable but which do not affect the operational requirements of the goods and such changes shall not affect the validity of the contract.

13. PACKAGING
13.1 The Buyer shall meet the cost of any special packaging requested by the Buyer or any packaging rendered necessary by delivery by any means other than the Seller's normal means of delivery. The Buyer shall remain solely responsible for the disposal of all packaging in accordance with all regulations (whether statutory or otherwise) relating to the protection of the environment.
13.2 The Seller shall be entitled to invoice the Buyer for the cost of all pallets and other returnable packaging material unless the same are returned to the Seller in good condition (damage paid within 30 days of the date of delivery).
14. LICENCES AND CONSENTS
14.1 Any licence or consent of any government or other authority shall be required for the acquisition, carriage or use of the goods by the Buyer the Buyer shall obtain the same at its own expense and if requested produce evidence of the same to the Seller on demand. Failure to obtain any licence or consent shall not entitle the Buyer to withhold or delay payment of the price. Any additional expenses or charges incurred by the Seller resulting from such failure shall be for the Buyer's account.
15. FORCE MAJEURE
15.1 The Seller shall not be liable to the Buyer for any loss or damage which may be suffered by the Buyer as a direct or indirect result of the supply of goods by the Seller being prevented, hindered, delayed, cancelled or rendered uneconomic by reason of circumstances or events beyond the Seller's reasonable control ("force majeure circumstances") including but not limited to acts of God war riot strike lock-out trade dispute or labour disturbance accident break-down of plant or machinery the flood storm difficulty or increased expense in obtaining workman materials or transport or other circumstances affecting the supply of the goods or of raw materials by the Seller's normal source of supply or the manufacture of the goods by the Seller's normal means or the delivery of the goods by the Seller's normal mode or means of delivery.
15.2 In force majeure circumstances the Seller may in its sole discretion terminate any contract for the supply of goods pursuant to these Conditions or cancel delivery of goods to the Buyer or may, with the agreement of the Buyer, deliver goods at an agreed rate of delivery commencing after any suspension of deliveries.
15.3 If due to force majeure circumstances the Seller has insufficient stocks to meet all its commitments the Seller may apportion available stocks between its customers at its sole discretion.

16. SAMPLES
Any sample supplied to the Buyer are supplied solely for information and in no way import any implied conditions or warranties as to quality, description, fitness for purpose or merchantable quality and the Buyer shall be deemed to have satisfied itself as to such matters prior to ordering the goods.
17. TERMINATION
17.1 If the Buyer being an individual enters into a voluntary arrangement or an application is presented for the making of a bankruptcy order against him or of the companies with his creditors or if being a company an application for an order to make a resolution is passed for the winding-up of the Buyer otherwise than for the purposes of amalgamation or reconstruction previously approved in writing by the Seller or if a meeting is called to approve the appointment of a liquidator to the Buyer or if a petition is presented to the Court for the appointment of a liquidator to the Buyer or if a receiver, manager, administrative receiver or administrator is appointed or a petition is presented to the Court for an appointment of an administrator of the Buyer or over any part of the Buyer's undertaking of a circumstances arise which might entitle the Court or a creditor of the Buyer to appoint a receiver, manager, administrative receiver or administrator or which might entitle the Court to make a winding-up order or if the Buyer takes or suffers any similar or analogous action in consequence of debt or commits a breach of any contract between the Seller and the Buyer the Seller may without prejudice to any of its other rights stop any goods in transit and/or suspend further deliveries to the Buyer and/or exercise its rights under Condition 7 and/or by notice in writing to the Buyer terminate any contract with the Buyer.
17.2 Upon termination of any contracts pursuant to Condition 17.1 any indebtedness of the Buyer to the Seller shall become immediately due and payable and the Seller shall be relieved of any further obligation to supply any goods to the Buyer pursuant to such contracts.

18. ASSIGNMENT
None of the rights or obligations of the Buyer under these Conditions may be assigned or transferred in whole or in part without the prior written consent of the Seller.
19. HEALTH AND SAFETY AT WORK ETC
The Buyer agrees to pay due regard to any information supplied by the Seller relating to the use for which the goods are designed to have been tested or concerning conditions necessary to ensure that they will be safe and without risk to health at all times when they are being set, used, cleaned or maintained by any person at work, and the Buyer undertakes to take such steps as may be specified by the above information to ensure that as far as reasonably practicable the goods will be safe and without risk to health at all times as are mentioned above.

20. LIEN
The Seller shall be entitled to a general lien on all goods and property owned by the Buyer in the Seller's possession (though the Buyer may have paid for the same in full) in satisfaction of the whole or part as the case may be of the unpaid price of any goods sold and delivered to the Buyer under any contract. The Seller shall be entitled to offset any sum or sums owing to the Seller from the Buyer against any sums owed by the Buyer to the Seller.
21. HEADINGS
The headings of these Conditions do not form part of the Conditions and shall not affect their interpretation.
22. NON-PERFORMANCE BY THE BUYER
The Seller reserves the right to suspend performance of any contract in the event of material or persistent non-performance by the Buyer in relation to any contract between the Buyer and the Seller.
23. SEVERABILITY
If any of these Conditions are held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect whether in whole or in part such invalidity illegality or unenforceability shall not prejudice the effectiveness of the rest of these Conditions or the remainder of any part of a Condition affected.
24. WAIVER
Failure by the Seller to exercise or enforce any rights under any contract subject to these Conditions shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any such right nor operate so as to bar the exercise or enforcement of such right at any time thereafter.
25. NOTICES
Any notice hereunder shall be in writing and be deemed to have been duly given if delivered personally or sent by pre-paid first class post (airmail) to an address outside the United Kingdom (to be specified in the party concerned at his last known address. Notices delivered personally shall be deemed to have been given when delivered, notices sent by first class post shall be deemed to have been given seven days after dispatch (business days) given by airmail and notices sent by telex or telefax shall be deemed to have been given on the date of dispatch.

26. GOVERNING LAW
Any contract to which these Conditions apply shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the Laws of England and the parties hereby submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
